This organization creates wearable QR codes that you can purchase for low cost. If a person is missing and wearing the QR code the person who finds them can scan the code and all of the person’s information will be uploaded so they can return home.

PROJECT LIFESAVER

Project Lifesaver is a 501 (C)(3) community based, public safety, non-profit organization that provides law enforcement, fire/rescue, and caregivers with a program designed to protect, and when necessary, quickly locate individuals with cognitive disorders who are prone to the life threatening behavior of wandering. The method relies on proven radio technology and specially trained search and rescue teams. Citizens enrolled in Project Lifesaver wear a small transmitter on the wrist or ankle that emits an individualized frequency

signal. If an enrolled client goes missing, the caregiver notifies their local Project Lifesaver agency, and a trained emergency team responds to the wanderer's area. The first responders will then use the client's individualized frequency to locate the position of the individual. *The link above is to locate your nearest agency (usually police departments).*

4. There are some watches that can be worn that connect to cell phone service plans. Children have the ability to call people from the phone which may be a distraction in class. For example Jibit and TickTalk.

Yellow Dot NY Sheriffs

Yellow Dot is a free program designed to help first responders provide life-saving medical attention during that first "golden hour" after a crash or other emergency. A Yellow Dot in the driver's-side rear window of your vehicle will alert first responders that vital medical information is stored in the glove compartment.
